## Thanksgiving!

#### "Oh, give thanks to the Lord, for He is good; for His steadfast love endures forever!" (1 Chronicles 16:34)

Thanksgiving is coming. It is a time when we are supposed to give thanks...right? Well then, what are you thankful for? Maybe we give thanks for our over abundance of food, or our name brand clothes, or maybe even our well built homes. I would say these are all good things for which we should give thanks to God. However, there is usually something we leave off our list of thanksgivings. How about being thankful for...our sufferings.

Let me be the first one to say how odd it is to say we should be "thankful" for suffering. Being thankful for pain, for emotional trauma, for disease, for broken relationships, it just seems to go against our very grain, doesn't it? Who on earth wants to suffer? I don't. I doubt you do either. Actually I think we try our best to avoid suffering.

But, the truth is, every single one of us will go through suffering in this life. It's a fact. Suffering is guaranteed in this fallen world (Genesis 3). We will each face battles unique to our own nature. We will face spiritual sufferings and physical temptations which can lead to suffering. Our minds and our bodies will, at some point, fail. And yes, then there is death. Each of us will watch the ones we love the most...die. One day, we ourselves will also go through death. None of us are immune to it...Depressing, isn't it. Yet, if you crack open your Bible to 2 Corinthians 5:3, the Apostle Paul says, "We rejoice in our sufferings." Why would he say that? Well, I think Paul understood the secret of not just enduring suffering, but actually seeing it as a place where God can work something good. Just as God turned the terribleness of the cross into the salvation of the entire world, the Apostle Paul was also able to see how God can, from His upper story, turn the terribleness of suffering we go through into something good, beneficial, and faith strengthening in our lower story.

Paul goes on to say that while it might not feel that way...God reminds us over and over, "My grace is sufficient for you, for my power is made perfect in weakness." And while weakness just feels like another form of suffering...weakness leads to trusting in the one who is strong. Which is something to truly be thankful for.

So, this thanksgiving, Give thanks! Give thanks for all the good you can see, and give thanks for all the good you cannot see. For the Lord is good, His steadfast love (mercy) endures forever.

## **Updates from The Church Council**

The major remodel work is complete and a few finishing touches, such as display boards, are finishing up around the church. Thanks again to everyone for their patience and contributions to this project over the past six months. The next big item we are waiting for is the arrival and installation of the five roof top HVAC units that will replace the ones that are 24 years old. We anticipate this will happen sometime in November!

Our building loan now has a balance of \$69,997! In October we were able to make another principal payment of \$13,785 from designated offerings and the loan will now be paid off no later than this coming February 2024! At the end of this year the balance will be just over \$36,000, minus any contributions we receive towards the principal of the loan in the last 2 months of 2023. God willing, the loan has a realistic chance of being paid off at the end of the year!

Preliminary work on the 2024 budget has begun! We ask for your prayers as we look for His guidance to manage the resources He has blessed our congregation with. The budget, election of council members and many other exciting updates will be provided at our Annual Meeting on Sunday, January 21, 2024 at 1:00pm. Please mark your calendars now and plan to attend!

Our Mites at work for November: The SD Mission Grant #6: Luther's Small Catechism for African Mission-Lutheran

Heritage Foundation - \$5,000. Due to the *tremendous* growth in the Lutheran churches in Africa, missionaries, partner churches and Lutheran leaders throughout Africa have requested more than 3 dozen translations of the *Small Catechism*. This grant will help fund the texts needed to teach the faith when the pastors are stretched beyond their limits to personally instruct new believers.

The 2023-2025 LWML Mission Grant #2: A Healing Space for At-Risk Children – Dakota Boys and Girls Ranch, ND - \$100,000. This grant will help meet the construction costs of building a chapel facility specifically designed to be a healing space for traumatized boys and girls, to help them know and experience the mercy of Christ and His healing power.


