Hebrews 11 is a chapter that speaks about living life with trust in the gracious promises of God – about living with faith in the awesome works of God. The verses in this chapter urge us to recall how God has used people who faithfully served Him to carry forward the life of Church (this chapter specifically speaks of many believers in God's promise of the Savior who lived even before Jesus was born). The faith and service of God's people are remembered and celebrated!

In the spirit of Hebrews 11, I urge you to celebrate the following examples of blessing from

our Lord:

- 1. We celebrate Kathy Holdorf's work among us for 21 years as she retires from her service here at Memorial. Much of this past month Kathy has been training Melinda Wood and Cole Heyd to carry forward the work she's being doing as our Administrative Manager. So much has taken place over these past 21 years and Kathy's done so much over these years to help our ministry be as effective as possible. - 2. While Director of Christian Education Liz Peters has been with us as our Director of Children's Ministry for 17 years, this fall she celebrates her 25th Anniversary of service to the whole Church as a DCE (her first 8 years + a year of internship were served at St.John's Lutheran

Church in Yankton). Liz's love for the Lord and her love for children blend together to help move Memorial forward in connecting our kids to our Lord Jesus! Congratulations, Liz, as we praise God for how He uses people for special service in full-time church work!

- 3. You may not have known that Jan Noah has been a church organist at Memorial for 60 years! And that doesn't count her 4 years at Peace Lutheran in Rock Rapids or the 3 years she played at Faith Lutheran in Sioux City. This obviously means that Jan started playing organ for church at a very young age! Thank you, Jan, for modeling servanthood in how you use your musical gifts!

A major building project in 2008-2009 nearly doubled the size of the initial building footprint.
