

Forgiveness!

"What does

Lent mean

to me?"

With the month of March being consumed with the Lenten season, I find myself asking the question, "What does Lent mean to me?" I think it is a question that we have all wrestled with at some point in time

throughout our lives. Or maybe you haven't yet. And that's okay, because today is the day.

I asked this question to some of the High Schoolers here at Memorial and the answers I received were...well...expected.

We explored words like, fasting, repentance, sin and darkness. These are all good words, and they all describe our Lenten journey, but the one word that didn't find its way into our conversation was "forgiveness". Now I know that forgiveness is part of repentance, or at least it feels like you have to have one to get the other...but, as the kids and I explored this word "forgiveness" Jesus' words on the cross came to mind. "And when they came to the place that is called The Skull, there they crucified Him, and the criminals, one on His right and one on His left. And Jesus said, "Father, forgive them, for they know not what they do." (Luke 23:33-34)

Now, out of all the words that Jesus could have spoken, one of forgiveness is not on my list. Yet, as the nails were being pounded in and the blood poured down, He didn't call down curses, shout angry things or even defiantly make a stand. No, what He did was even more profound than that. Jesus forgave them. Forgiveness offered freely. Forgiveness given to all, even those who were responsible for nailing Him there. Christ died to forgive all sins. For the sins of those who nailed Him there, for the sins of all the generations before them, for the sins that I have committed, and even for the sins that you have committed. It is why Jesus came: "For the Son of Man came to seek and to save the lost" (Luke 19:10).

But He also made a point of saying that we should do the same...forgive others that is. And this is not always easy, in fact it is very, very hard. But forgiveness transforms us.

Forgiveness moves our anger and our hurt into healing and peace. Forgiveness allows us to set down this giant burden that we weren't meant to carry in the first place. Forgiveness is not about letting someone off the hook for a wrongdoing, or forgetting about the past, or forgetting about the pain. It certainly does not mean

that you stick around for future mistreatment, but it is about setting yourself free so that you can move forward. And in doing so, you become a living witness to God's love and restoration in a very simple yet powerful way.

"Father, forgive them." It is what He came for. It is why we take time during Lent to reflect on all that God has given us. It is one of the most important words ever, a word of forgiveness.

The March mites in action:

From LWML is Light of Christ in Eastern Europe, Mission Central- \$56,000

For decades, Christians in Germany and Czech Republic had to hide their faith. Churches that stood for centuries were closed and generations lived with no knowledge of the Christian faith. The Lutheran Church is striving to meet the urgent need to bring the love and light of Christ to people who have been living in spiritual darkness. Recently, immigrants and refugees from the Middle East have settled in Europe, many in Germany. Our missionaries are meeting the additional challenge of reaching out to those of the Muslim faith with the message of the Triune God. Thousands of immigrants, and German and Czech citizens of all ages, need to hear the Gospel. This grant will help in the support of eight missionaries working in Germany and the Czech Republic.

From LWML South Dakota District - Dakota Boys and Girls Ranch, Chapel Audio Equipment — \$3,000 The Dakota Boys and Girls Ranch serves children whose lives have been impacted by neglect, abuse, & many adverse negative experiences. On the Minot campus, the Kruse Memorial Chapel serves as the weekly chapel service site and gathering place. This grant will aid in helping to replace the aging audio equipment in this chapel.
