It's Hard to Wait!

Waiting is hard. We want what we're anticipating to happen now! A fun trip? The new movie or video game? A championship for your sports team? Lunch? Or maybe just the dessert part? (there's a reason that many have said, "Life is short, so eat dessert first!"). How about opening your Christmas presents?

We find ourselves longing for what easily satisfies our wants – sometimes to the point of forgetting or even ignoring the greater blessing that may be coming down the road. Sometimes we get desperate and jump the gun on something still not ready – such as fruit that's still ripening, or a cake that hasn't fully baked. The Bible speaks often about exercising patience. It is listed as a fruit of the Spirit in Galatians 5:22. Yet patience is so hard to come by!

I believe the season of Advent can be really helpful for us. While we're looking for Christmas to already be here, Advent tells us: "Wait a little bit (or a lot?). The process is still taking place." When we wait for Christmas, we join the people of God who spent their lives waiting for the birth of the Savior. We join the whole church in the fulfilling joy of the greatest Gift ever received when our waiting yields to the celebration of Jesus' birth!

But don't forget this – Advent prepares us to patiently look for the return of our Lord Jesus! In their letters to the early church (the epistles found in the New Testament), the apostles speak often of patience as we anticipate what we do not yet have and as we experience the difficulties of this earthly life. And, yes, the waiting can be hard, especially when we find ourselves suffering and hurting.

I certainly don't know why Jesus hasn't returned yet, but the apostles hint at understanding God's patience as He longs for human hearts to become confident in His promises and trust in His ways. The Scriptures call us to repentance – to turn away from our dependence on things that don't last and are not able to provide the life we so desperately need. The Scriptures call us to anticipate Jesus' return with joy for the rescue He brings!

This year, Advent is as short on the calendar as it can possibly be. But I encourage you to embrace the season of Advent and allow your patience to grow long, fully comforted and held by the promises of our coming Savior!

SPOTLIGHT ON MISSION GRANTS:

2023-2025 LWML MISSION GRANT #3: Serving God's Children with special needs – Journeys Lutheran School, Milwaukee, WI - \$100,000. The mission of Journeys Lutheran School is to serve God's children ages eight to 21 with special needs. This grant will help the school purchase two vans to transport high school students enrolled in School-to-Work Internship Programs and students taking elective classes at nearby Martin Luther High School.

SD LWML MISSION GRANT #7: Mozambique Dorcas Sewing Project, LCMS International Mission Africa Region - \$5,000.
