We have two May mites in action:

1. Redeeming Life Maternity Home, Illinois Expansion, Redeeming Life Outreach Ministries - \$100,000

Redeeming Life currently operates maternity and transitional homes in Central Florida for single pregnant women who are homeless, abused, and/or at-risk of abortion. This grant will help support a called deaconess to serve in in the Chicagoland area. Additionally, the funds will help offset costs, during the first two years, of operating a safe & stable home (rent, utilities, food) and provide program services for the women. The goal is for the residents to learn to live independently and offers many opportunities for the women to understand that, in Christ, there is forgiveness, peace, and unconditional love.

2. Mercy Medical Care for Tanzania, Mwadui Lutheran School & Community - \$68,182

Mwadui Lutheran School in Shinyanga, Tanzania, has become one of the leading schools in the region. It is educating many new pastors, teachers, and professionals from all over western Tanzania. This educational facility has become a valuable Christian outreach ministry. The next step is starting a medical clinic. This grant will purchase medical equipment, medical supplies, and medicine to treat the various illnesses of the student community.



New LWML South Dakota District Mission Grants will be selected at the Convention in June.


